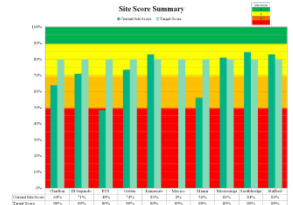


## **BCP Metrics – Using Metrics to Measure Your Program’s Compliance and Recovery Capability**
